5. RELATIONSHIP TO PARENT AWARD AND AGREEMENT

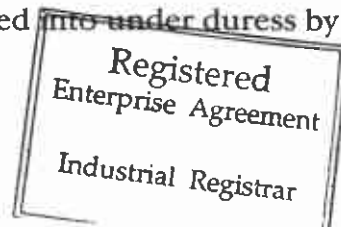
It has been determined by the parties to this Enterprise Agreement that the agreement shall:

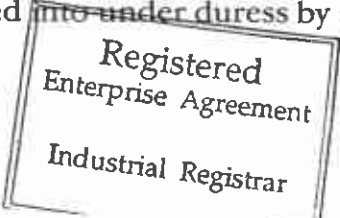

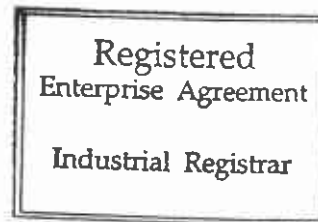

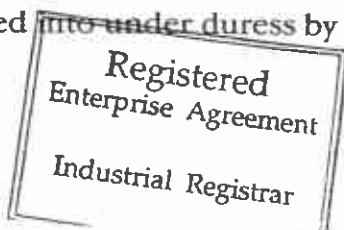
