LIME MAKERS, &c. (STATE) CONCILIATION COMMITTEE

Application by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales, industrial organisation of employees.

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. The Lime Makers, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee published 11 June 1993 (275 I.G. 561), be dissolved.
2. There be established a new Lime Makers, &c. (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Labourers engaged in or in connection with lime making, including limestone miners and all labourers in or about limestone mines or quarries in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna;

excepting employees of —

Blue Circle Southern Cement;
The Kandos Cement Company Limited;
The Broken Hill Proprietary Company Limited;
Australian Iron and Steel Proprietary Limited within the jurisdiction of the Iron and Steel Works Employees (Australian Iron & Steel Proprietary Limited) Conciliation Committee and the Quarries (Australian Iron and Steel Pty Limited) Conciliation Committee;

and excepting also —

Engine drivers and firemen, greasers, trimmers, cleaners, and pumpers engaged in or about the driving of engines, electrical crane, winch and motor drivers;
Employees within the jurisdiction of the Cement Workers, &c. (State)
Conciliation Committee.

3. The said committee shall consist of one representative of employers and one representative of employees.
4. The representative of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Chamber of Manufactures of New South Wales (Industrial).
5. The representative of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by The AWU-FIME Amalgamated Union, New South Wales.
6. This order shall take effect on and from 24 October 1995.
