ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Wholesale Fruit and Vegetable (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Employees engaged in or in connection with the handling, reception, sale or delivery of fruit and/or vegetables by wholesale at the City Municipal Markets, Sydney, and at other wholesale fruit and vegetable markets or wholesale fruit and vegetable distributing centres in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna, the County of Northumberland, the Parish of Stockton, and the Municipality of Raymond Terrace;

and excepting also employees within the jurisdiction of the Clerks (State) Conciliation Committee; and drivers and extra hands employed on motor or horse-drawn vehicles.

2. The said committee shall consist of three representatives of employers and three representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, three by The New South Wales Chamber of Fruit and Vegetable Industries.

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, three by the Shop, Distributive and Allied Employees' Association, New South Wales.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 27 March 1996.
