**ORDER**

The Industrial Relations Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Public Hospitals Scientific Officers/Medical Technologists (State) Conciliation Committee for the industries and callings of —

Persons employed in public hospitals in the State, excluding the County of Yancowinna, in any of the following callings or avocations, who hold qualifications appropriate to their callings or avocations, or who are employed as trainees whilst pursuing a course of study leading to such qualifications —

Medical Technologists and Scientific Officers.

2. The said committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.
3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, by the Health Administration Corporation of New South Wales.
4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, one by The Health and Research Employees' Association of New South Wales and one by the Public Service Association of New South Wales.

NOTE: Where the committee is dealing with a matter or matters relating solely to a member or members of one union, the nominees of the other union shall not sit so as to enable the union representing the members concerned to have both nominees sit as the employee members for the hearing or hearings in question.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 8 August 1996.
