BUTTON MAKERS, &c. (STATE) INDUSTRIAL COMMITTEE

INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS COMMISSION OF NEW SOUTH WALES

Application by The Textile Clothing and Footwear Union of New South Wales, industrial organisation of employees.

(No. IRC 6076 of 1996)

ORDER

The Commission orders that —

1. There be established a new Button Makers, &c. (State) Industrial Committee for the industries and callings of —

Employees engaged in the manufacture and/or treatment of buckles and buttons made from casein, mother-of-pearl, or metal, and of badges made from casein, wood, cloth and mother-of-pearl, excluding the County of Yancowinna.

2. The said Committee shall consist of two representatives of employers and two representatives of employees.

3. The representatives of employers shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by Australian Business Limited (formerly the Chamber of Manufactures of NSW Ltd).

4. The representatives of employees shall be appointed, upon nomination as prescribed, two by The Textile Clothing and Footwear Union of New South Wales.

5. This order shall take effect on and from 17 December 1996.
