PADDY PALLIN ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT 2003

1. Title

This Agreement shall be known as the Paddy Pallin Enterprise Agreement 2003

2. Arrangement

3. Parties Bound.

This Agreement shall apply to and be binding upon:

- 3.1. Paddy Pallin Pty Limited ("the Company");
- 3.2. The Transport Workers' Union of New South Wales; and
- 3.3. Each and every employee of the Company.

4. Date and Duration of Agreement

This Agreement will commence from the date of its certification by the Industrial Relations Commission of New South Wales and shall remain in force for a period of 3 years. This Agreement shall continue to be binding upon the parties beyond this date until replaced by another Certified Agreement or terminated by the parties.

5. Wage/Salary Sacrifice Into Superannuation

- 5.1. Employees can choose to make voluntary contributions to the Australian Retirement Fund by means of wage or salary deduction.
- 5.2. Where an employee elects in writing on the approved form to salary sacrifice part of their wage or salary for the provision of superannuation benefits, the following shall apply:
 - 5.2.1. The wage/salary sacrificed part of their wages will be deemed to form part of their wage or agreed salary;
 - 5.2.2. The amount which an employee elects to sacrifice when added to the normal employer contributions for an employee, must not exceed the age based deductible limit as determined by the Australian Taxation Office;
 - 5.2.3. The Company will make such arrangements as are necessary to facilitate an employee making voluntary contributions by way of salary/wage sacrifice into the Australian Retirement Fund;
 - 5.2.4. All employee voluntary wage/salary sacrifice contributions for the provision of superannuation benefits shall be remitted to the Australian Retirement Fund at the same time as the Company's

compulsory contribution in accordance with the Superannuation Guarantee (Administration) Act 1992 each month;

5.2.5. The Company will specify on its pay advice to its employees the amount of the salary/wage sacrifice provided to the Australian Retirement Fund together with details of the employer contribution.

6. Dispute Resolution Procedure

The parties to this Agreement shall comply with the dispute settlement procedure provided for in the Clothing Trades (State) Award as amended from time to time.
